

INMATE TELEPHONE SYSTEM:

Inmates have use of a vendor provided telephone system. Some basic information about the telephone system:

1. Inmates have 2 ways to call out—collect and using funds from their commissary account.
2. Calls can be made internationally and within the continental U.S.
3. Three-way call attempts will automatically alert the phone system and the call will be terminated.
4. The telephones are turned on at 9:00 a.m. and turned off at 11:00 p.m. on weekdays. On weekends the telephones are turned on at 9:00 a.m. and turned off at 1:00 a.m.
5. All calls are recorded and may be reviewed/monitored by staff.
