INMATE VISITATION RULES:

- 1. Inmates are permitted two visits a week. Visits are limited to 20 minutes. All visits are recorded and may be reviewed / monitored by staff members.
- 2. Any violation of facility rules may result in the cancellation of the visit.
- 3. Visitors must produce positive identification (picture ID). This can be in the form of a state issued driver's license or state I.D. card. Visitors will be denied access without an I.D.
- 4. Inmates may have only one visit per day, consisting of a maximum of two adults and two minor children.
- 5. Visitors under the age of 17 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. An inmate's legal guardian(s) may visit after approval through administration. A guardian's visits will be in addition to other authorized visits.
- 6. All visitors must be fully and appropriately dressed; act and behave properly. NO CELL PHONES / ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT ARE ALLOWED IN VISITATION. NO PHOTOGRAPHS / RECORDINGS OF INMATES ARE ALLOWED WITHOUT PRIOR AUTHORIZATION.
- 7. Nothing can be carried into the visitation room (purses, packages, sacks, books, food, beverages, etc.) by visitors. Officers are not allowed to hold any property for visitors. Any visitor who brings, or attempts to bring, any unauthorized item into the facility may be denied visitation and may be subject to criminal prosecution. Visitors may be restricted from visiting inmates at the discretion of facility personnel for any violations of visitation rules. This restriction may be for a limited period of time up to permanent denial.
- 8. A visit may be denied to any person if there is reason to believe the visit may not be in the best interest of the security and welfare of the facility.
- 9. Attorney and Minister Visits will not count as a visit and are in addition to the two personal visits authorized per week.
- 10. Any deviation from these guidelines must be approved by facility staff in advance.
